

Prof. Juozas Vidas Gražulevičius (male) is professor at the Department of Polymer Chemistry and Technology at Kaunas University of Technology. He is expert in the synthesis and investigation of organic semiconductors and emitters for optoelectronic applications. He has spent extended periods at Heriot-Watt University Chemical Department (Edinburgh, Great Britain), Bayreuth University Department of Macromolecular Chemistry (Germany), Lancaster University, Center of Polymers (Great Britain), Cergy-Pontoise University (France), National University of Singapore. J.V. Gražulevičius has published more than 380 papers in international journals, which were cited more than 5900 times and five review articles (h=33). He is co-author of 25 international patents and 5 chapters of books published by the international publishers. He was scientific supervisor of 20 defended doctoral theses. He is a full member of Lithuanian Academy of Sciences. He is a winner of Lithuanian National Science Prizes in 1997 and 2008 and of the prize for science of Baltic Assembly (2014).
